



C.G., Feng shui „L“ house
(analysis based on the architectonic map)

Dear C.G,

I can imagine this house with the yard and covered terrace as a very bright place surrounded with the grass, but there are some pitfalls that should be corrected.

Please take a look at the map (in the attachment) and see that it is divided into 9 sectors. Sector 7 and 6 could not be colored on this paper; their colors are gray, white and all metal colors.

As you were especially interested in colors I am sending a suggestion on how to choose them in accord with Feng shui.

PROBLEMS TO BE SOLVED

1. The trouble with this house is that it has an „L“ basement, which means that two sectors are missing:
 - No 2, which means problems with partnerships, especially man-woman partnership
 - No 7 which indicates some problems with children or creativity.
 - Also, small part of the sectors 9, 5, and 1 are missing. Sector 9 is quite small – people who live there can have troubles with the filling of success, or they will question their life achievements.

Remedies: if you don't wish to invest and rebuild the house install strong light directed from the yard towards the house from the sector No.2. See the photo:



2. Toilet and the bathroom in sector No. 4 are problematic because there is too much dirty energy, that can block the abundance and growth of the family.

Remedies: it is always good to put a mirror on the WC door, or something that will reflect the light because that makes the WC disappear. Here you can put palm trees, bamboos and other plants that grow high. You can paint them as well. Here are the inspirations:



3. Other two toilets should be transformed as well. The toilet that is in the centre, sector No. 5 can damage the health of the inhabitants.
 - Another toilet in sector No. 6 can cause problems with the father or the protector of the family, it can even affect money income.

Remedies: in both of these toilets you can put stones, big, small, any; or sand. That will suppress the negative energy. Such stones will suppress the negative energy:



4. Are there still stairs between sectors 5 and 9? If yes, this staircase should be closed or walled so to say. I am sending the photo of the closed stairs.

Remedies if needed: wall them. Take a look at this photo:



COLOURS

- You should use colors as you see them in the map. The main colors are circled around the number that is used to mark the sector. The principle is that the major color in the

concrete sector should be as it is on the map – you can use other colors to contrast, but they should not be dominant.

For example:

Red color in sector No. 9 means you can use warm colors, basically any warm color: red, orange, vine, purple etc.

Then you can make a contrast with blue or beige, but the main color should be warm.

- Also notice that one or two colors are basic in one sector, but you can strengthen the energy there by adding the color that **strengthens** that certain area (see below).

Sectors should have colors as follows here:

Number: 1

Basic color: blue, black

This sector is strengthened by the colors of metal.

Number: 2

Basic color: ochre, beige, brown

This sector is **strengthened** by the red, orange and pink colors.

Number: 3

Basic color: green

This sector is strengthened by the blue and black.

Number: 4

Basic color: green

This sector is strengthened by the colors blue and black.

Number: 5

Basic color: yellow, also beige, brown.

Other colors can't strengthen it.

Number: 6

Basic color: all metal colors, silver, and white;

This sector is strengthened by the yellow color.

Number: 7

Basic color: all metal colors, silver, and white;

This sector is strengthened by the colors ochre, beige, brown.

Number: 8

Basic color: ochre, beige, brown

This sector is strengthened by the colors red and orange.

Number: 9

Basic color: red, orange and wine red

This sector is strengthened by the green color.

Your lucky directions:

Year of birth 1961

Feng shui Number is: 3

Lucky directions are as follows:

Sheng qi (luck, the most important direction) – South

Health – North

Love – South-East

Personal growth – East
